## 2<sup>nd</sup> Summer School on Conservation Genetics of Marine Organisms



The aim of the second summer school on conservation genetics is to increase the knowledge and disseminate the basic concepts in conservation genetics as an effective and modern tool for protecting and managing the biodiversity of marine environments.
